Colorado Child Support Services



Child support services are provided by your county human or social services agency. These services are available to help mothers, fathers, grandparents, and other caretakers with establishment and/or enforcement of a child support order.

These services include:

- Locating parties
- Modifying court orders, if needed
- Enforcing child and medical support
- Tracking account balances

Submit your application to the county of your choice! There is a one-time \$20 application fee.

The FSR works in conjunction with the Child Support Services program. If you choose to open a child support case, the FSR will continue to process payments.

Because Kids Matter Most Family Support Registry

The FSR is Colorado's child support and/or spousal maintenance payment processing center.

Their role is to serve as the central location to receive and disburse support payments.

They will maintain the official payment record for your court order.

Q: How is my FSR account created?

A:

The court enters your order into their system.

Your information is electronically transmitted to the FSR and your account is created automatically.

Both parties are mailed a New FSR Account Notice which includes the account number needed to receive or make payments.

Q: How do I make payments?

A: As the obligor, you have been ordered to pay child support and/or spousal maintenance. Here are your options:

Payment Methods

- Electronic check
- Recurring automatic withdrawal (RAW)
- Pay-by-Phone
- Credit/Debt card
- Mailing in a check/money order
- Cash through Money Gram
- Wage-withholding through employer

Include the following information with each payment:

- ✓ Your FSR account number
- ✓ Your name
- ✓ Your court case number
- ✓ The amount to pay for each FSR account, if you are paying on multiple FSR accounts

Q: How do I receive payments?

A: As the obligee, you have been ordered to receive child support and/or spousal maintenance payments. Here are your options:

Disbursement Methods

- Direct deposit
- FSR payment card (Reliacard Visa Debit)
- Check through the mail (default method)



Disbursements are generally issued within two business days following receipt of the payment.
