



WHEREAS, on June 5th, 1989, Governor Roy Romer signed into law the Colorado Administrative Procedure Act for the Establishment and Enforcement of Child Support; and

WHEREAS, on April 1st, 1990, this law, authorized county child support services agencies to establish, enforce, and modify child support orders by the use of Administrative Process Actions; and

WHEREAS, since April 1, 1990, over 93,000 child support orders have been established using Administrative Process Action; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 315 Colorado child support services professionals certified to conduct Administrative Process Actions; and

WHEREAS, county child support services professionals using Administrative Process Actions have benefited thousands of families throughout the state, nation, and world, by establishing and collecting millions of dollars of child support for children;

Therefore, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby proclaim, April 1, 2020, as
